







In Memoriam

WHAT HAS BEEN HAPPENING SO FAR TO SUPPORT DRAKE RESIDENTS?

Since Christmas Day, a coalition of partners has worked to support all residents who were displaced on Christmas Day with the following services, most of which are ongoing until the shelter closes.

- Safe shelter at Bethlehem Baptist Church and First Covenant Church.
- Meals coordinated at the disaster shelter sites by the Red Cross, the Salvation Army and generous donations from the community.
- Licensed health services from the Red Cross and Hennepin County with support from the City of Minneapolis Health Department.
- Licensed mental health services from MAD DADS of Minneapolis, the Red Cross, Hennepin County and the Minnesota Department of Health.
- Space for community-based groups in the disaster shelter at First Covenant Church to deliver wraparound services and to fill gaps.
- Coordinated case management services from the Red Cross and Hennepin County to help meet the immediate, disaster-related needs of residents.
- Access to donated items as needed in the disaster shelter and at the two-day Multi-Agency Resource Center.
- Connections to service providers at the Multi-Agency Resource Center and through continued conversations with recovery caseworkers.

These services have all been integral to the overall response to this disaster and the residents affected. It has truly been a community-wide response.


