AGENDA-

- 1. Briana Koch from Ryan Companies joining us to discuss her plans for Mill District, bringing awareness to Downtown (currently ~20 community and business leaders)
 - a. Deliverables are communication and mapping and utilizing existing resources (i.e. skyway, parks, etc.) *leaning into Mill District neighborhood and moving away from Downtown East name*
 - b. Tentative goals are seeking partnership with ETBP (non-competitive support), amplifying Mill District as part of East Town
 - c. Collaboration could be opportunity for branding for Elliot Park (broad vision is not going to apply to separate neighborhoods)
 - d. ETBP not being seen or applicable to Coalition = reality check for our purpose, partnerships, and goals
 - e. Shannon sees it as extra bandwidth on development's part will not be sustainable, so ETBP fills gaps and holds overarching mission
 - f. ETBP is a business organization, and the two neighborhoods are affected by business but have secular identities
 - i. Concern around East Town coming to neighborhoods and claiming overlay and enforcing name
 - *ii.* What are ways to circle back to our identity as a business-based organization? Do we need to change our pace?
 - iii. Not advocating Ryan Companies or this project unless membership is secured, Matt + Rich are part of project to keep tabs
- 2. Annual Report Approval: Motioned Cassie Garner, Seconded Amy Carlson
- 3. Annual Meeting
 - a. Location will not be at US Bank, Guthrie would require catering, could reach out to The Depot
 - b. Rich will check in to see if Sherman Associates can host meeting, Eato could possibly supply appetizers- status update by next month
- 4. Walking Tour
 - a. Shannon will reach out for Guthrie "yellow room" April 27th? June evening?
 - b. Eato can be used as a drop-off for swag bags (will be members only)

- 5. Other Event Updates
 - a. HH next week @ Macphail, Coffee @ MMVC in April, HH @ The Larking in May, potential HH @ Gold Medal Park with Be That Neighbor/Guthrie in June?
 - b. EPNI tree plantings in April and May, Annual spring clean-up in Elliot Park around Earth Day – connect with Wako to join Elliot Park newsletter
 - c. March 7th evening- Public Safety Forum with Coalition for Elliot Park
 - d. Coalition meetings are not public, Board is invited to attend but only shareable with Elliot Park invested parties
- The Bazement nightclub business on Washington Ave opposed by residents and CM Rainville for liquor license, now being recommended for approval, Shannon had reached out to CM Cashman, so she is aware
 - a. Access to alley behind Crooked Pint, ADA entrance in front of Crooked Pint
- 7. Financial Updates
 - a. Quarterly billing has levelled some cash flow, investigating website updates which would also assist
 - b. 4 members paid this month, 3 members invoiced (including Armory), 10 recruiting members are in various status (green = good to go, yellow = possible/in steps, red = not started yet)
 - i. Creating and amplifying separation of members-only perks
 - ii. Clarifying narrative around benefits of membership and sponsorship
 - Jessy will add "sharing member events" as a benefit to membership page
 - iv. Hilton Garden Inn will likely not renew membership (Miriam Gutzmann has left), will need to reconnect
- 8. Strategic Plan
 - a. MDC operations on hold, Shannon hoping to hire by end of April for marketing support
 - b. Partnership Engagement Fund applied for with EPNI to support Coalition, possibly hiring support for the Coalition
- 9. Other Updates
 - a. Liquor license being considered for adult entertainment venue on 3rd Ave "Peppermint Hippo" (spin-off of "Spearmint Rhino")
 - b. Adventurama coming back June 8th (Event sponsor \$3000, Pit-stop sponsor \$8000) Elliot Park could possibly be a host
 - c. Gamut Gallery has officially transferred ownership as of this week
 - d. Wendy Underwood will be leaving the Board + Keith Kozerski will be joining
